An official transcript of grades received during four years of high school or three years of high school and the last year of junior high or middle school must be received by the board at the above address no later than April 10, 2019. If applicant is presently attending college, an official grade transcript must be provided directly to us from the institution by U.S. Mail.

All applicants must complete and file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), and then forward a copy of the Electronic Student Aid Report (ESAR) - the form returned to you for verification - in a separate sealed envelope along with your scholarship application. This form is an integral and private part of your scholarship application that is for the exclusive use of our scholarship evaluators.
