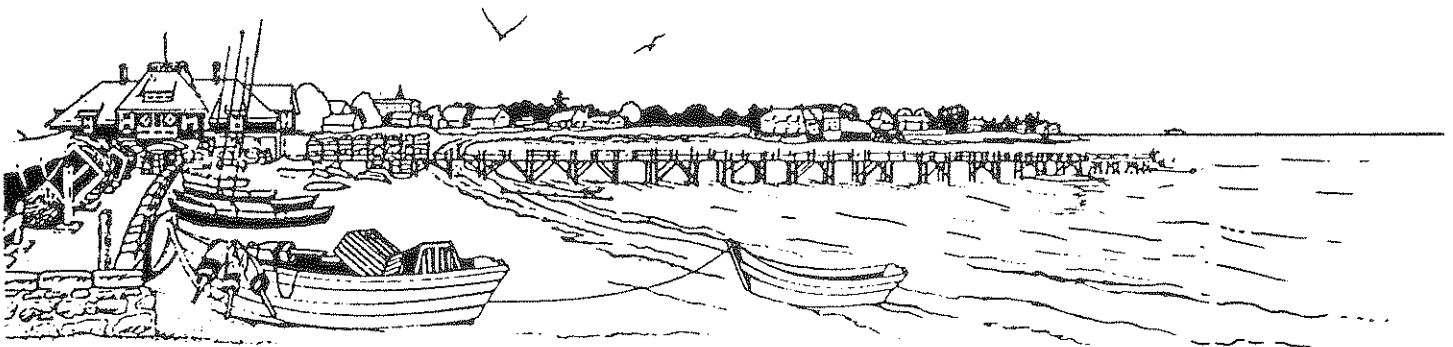

James J. McCarriston Swampscott Rotary Trade Scholarship

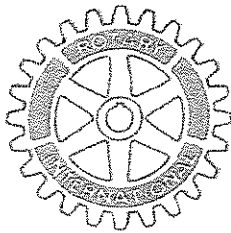

This is available to residents of Swampscott, Salem, Marblehead, Lynn and surrounding towns. The value of the scholarship will be determined by the courses being taken and will be available to cover courses, books, certification and licensing classes. Funds may also be available to help fund a work-study program if a suitable one can be arranged.

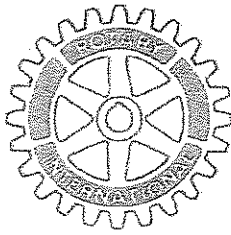
