In honor of our church's years of high community commitment and involvement under the leadership of Rev. Anita Farber-Robertson, the Scholarship Committee seeks to grant one-time college scholarships to students who: demonstrate financial need; are members of a minority community; are first-generation college students; OR have a proven record of commitment to community and/or social action. High academic achievement is not required for consideration. Instead, we seek applicants who possess a commitment to bettering their community and their own circumstances. The amount(s) of the scholarship(s) awarded will range from \$500 to \$2,500, and will be awarded to one or more students.

In order to be considered by the Scholarship Committee, the application must be completed in full and submitted **with all required documents** to your school's Guidance Department by **Tuesday, May 29th, 2018**. Award notification will be provided to your school's Guidance Department on or before June 1, 2018.. *By 8:00 AM !!*
