### ABOUT:

The YMCA of Metro North is a local charitable organization dedicated to strengthening communities by offering programs and services focused on Youth Development, Healthy Living and Social Responsibility. Every day, we work side-by-side with our neighbors to make sure that everyone, regardless of age, income or background, has the opportunity to learn, grow and thrive.

In 2019 we are eager to award high school seniors OR current college/vocational training students from our service area the third annual Youth Champion Scholarship in the amount of \$1000, for their personal work strengthening their community and displaying the YMCA values of honesty, respect, caring and responsibility.

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicant must be a resident of Lynn, Lynnfield, Nahant, Melrose, Peabody, Revere, Saugus or Stoneham.
- Preference will be given to applicants with ties to the YMCA of Metro North (Lynn Y/Melrose Y/Saugus Y/Torigian Y/Gymnastics Center/Melrose Y Academy/Stoneham Y Academy).
- Applicant must be a graduating senior of an accredited public, private, parochial, vocational or charter high school and must be accepted to an accredited institution of higher education or vocational training program **OR** already currently enrolled and attending an institution of higher education or vocational training program.
- Applicant must be willing to speak at our Y Champions Celebration Breakfast on May 23, 2019.

### SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. **Completed Application with necessary signatures.**
2. **Typed Essay response.**
3. **One letter of recommendation from a teacher, mentor, coach or supervisor.**

### AFTER REVIEW:

- Application finalists will interview with members of the Scholarship Review Committee the week of April 22.
- Scholarship Recipients will be notified by April 29. Recipients may be required to give a short speech based on their essay at the Y Champions Celebration on May 23, 2019.
