3. Each applicant must submit the following
 - a. A current Valladolid Scholarship Application that has been completely filled out.
 - b. A typewritten essay of 250 to 500 words that answers this year's essay question: "How do you live out the principle of *fraternity (fellowship with others)* in your life whether in your personal life, at school, at church, or in other aspects of your life?"
 - c. An academic transcript of grades
 - i. From High School for graduating seniors
 - ii. From College for current college students
