The Newburyport Choral Society (NCS) offers a \$1,000 scholarship to a graduating senior who plans to major in music in college. The **Newburyport Choral Society Betty Gillette Scholarship** is named for one of the Choral Society's founding members, who sang with the chorus from 1934 to 2009. Past recipients have gone on to major in music education, performance (vocal and instrumental), and composition.

Application Requirements: Applicants must submit a completed application (below) which includes two essays; transcript of grades; and two written references. One reference must be from your high school music teacher (or equivalent). Additional references may be submitted if so desired. Each reference must include the reference's contact telephone number and email address.

Application Deadline: Completed applications are due **by April 15** and should be submitted via email to outreach@newburyportchoralsociety.org.
